

Protocol for the Promotion of SEXUAL FREEDOMS and SEX-GENDER DIVERSITY, and for the Prevention, Detection, and Response to SEXUAL and LGBTIQ+phobic VIOLENCE

In line with this, the International Congress of Migration Journalism constitutes a space that promotes sexual freedoms, sex-gender diversity, and the enjoyment of all people, regardless of identity. The organization is committed to ensuring this, and therefore, any person whose sexual freedom is affected, or who feels harmed due to their identity as a woman, gender identity, or sexual orientation, will find here a space for support and accompaniment.

It must be clear that porCausa will respond to any affront against freedom and the enjoyment of all participants.

The executive team at porCausa has received specific training on the prevention, detection, and support in situations of sexual and LGBTIQ+phobic violence.

The volunteers of the International Congress of Migration Journalism have also undergone specific training in line with the actions laid out in this Protocol.

If at any point your sexual freedoms are compromised or you feel harmed by sexist or LGBTIQ+phobic behavior, you can talk to us, and we will support you.

At every moment and in every space of the Congress, you have the right to enjoy and experience both the day and the night — including the party — freely.

Respect for everyone's sexual freedoms, gender identities,

and sexual orientations is one of the core values of porCausa, of this congress, of all our activities, and of our team.

In other words, this is why porCausa will not tolerate sexist, LGTBQ+phobic, and/or racist behavior, attitudes, or comments.

We understand that "no means no," and that this "no" must be accepted as the only valid answer. The passage of time, substance use, or any other justification does not excuse ignoring the "no" of women and LGTBQ+ people.

Above all, respect everyone's right to enjoy the congress and the celebration on equal terms.
